Dear Postal Customer:

Flyer's placed in customer's mailbox with out postage is against Postal Service Regulations as well as being contained in a Federal Criminal Statute. The Statute Codified in 18 U.S.C. 1725 reads as follows:

Whoever knowingly and willfully deposits any mailable matter such as statements of account, circulars, such as bills or other like matter, on which no postage has been paid, in any letter box established approved or accepted by the Postmaster General for the receipt or delivery of mail matter on any route with intent to avoid payment of lawful postage thereon, shall for each offense be fined not more than \$300.00 for each offense.

However, "door slots and nonlockable bins or troughs used in apartment housemailboxes are not letter boxes within the meaning 18 USC 1725 and NOT private mail receptacles. The standard for mailable matter not bearing postage found in or on private mail receptacles. The post or other support is not part of the receptacle."
