After reviewing bids from three local roofing contractors, the Board of Directors has chosen GM Roofing Company to work with our association on the upcoming mansards project. As you know, this is a major project for our association to undertake, and the Board of Directors is anxious for you, as a homeowner to be completely informed each step of the way.

This project will take approximately one year to complete. The roofers will begin the work in July and plan to complete four buildings per month, weather permitting. All units, including the clubhouse will receive the new mansards, except the following addresses, as they were done a few years ago: 4161-4175 Larwin Avenue; 4177-4191 Larwin Avenue; 4124-4132 Larwin Avenue; 4224-4243 Elizabeth Court.

The total cost for this project is \$786,000.00. Due to the rapid increases in the costs of shingles and plywood, the BOD has decided to purchase both at the beginning of the project. These materials will be safely stored for us by our contractor. The contractor will be paid upon completion of each building at a cost of approximately \$12,267.00 per building. Thanks to the Board of Directors and the Budget Committee, the association will be able to complete this project and still have about \$700,000.00 remaining in the Reserve Account. The best part-----there will be NO special assessment, there will be NO interest to pay, and there will be NO increase in your monthly dues to cover the cost of this project.

We will continue to keep you updated throughout this project, however, if you do have questions, a representative from GM Roofing will attend the June 16th CTHOA Homeowners' Meeting, to answer any questions you may have concerning the mansard project and how it will affect you.
