Lawn chairs & blankets encouraged; no bleacher seating provided; Patriot's picnic food court; JFTB Liberty Village Vendor Fair; Kids Fun Zone expanded; Evening Fireworks show; and much more! Alcohol, dogs, fireworks, & Motor homes prohibited. **Adults - photo I.D. required for admittance**. Those without photo ID must be accompanied by a parent/ guardian. #### POOL RULES

Summer is here! Please take a few minutes to review the pool rules. Our goal is to keep the pools open all summer long. That can be done if we adhere to these rules. The following are not allowed at any time in the pool area: TRES-PASSING, FOOD, SCUBA GEAR, CLIMBING FENCES, GLASSWARE, SWIM FINS, DIVING INTO THE POOL, LOUD MUSIC, SURFBOARDS, FRISBEES, CUT-OFFS OF ANY KIND, BIKES, SKATEBOARDS, SCOOTERS, HORSEPLAY, PATIO FURNITURE IN THE POOL, BALLOONS, SMOKING, PUSHING, RUNNING, BOISTEROUS OR OBSCENE LANGUAGE, ANIMALS, EXCESSIVE NOISE, STYROFOAM OBJECTS, METAL CANS OR OB-JECTS, OIL-BASED LOTIONS. Gates must remain locked and shut at all times. Never give your key to anyone at the gate. Maximum of 3 guests allowed at a time. There are NO lifeguards on duty. The buddy system is to be used at all times. All children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older. This is a STATE LAW. Infants and toddlers must wear a plastic swim diaper that has an elastic waist with elastic around both legs.
