Use the Pools, Obey the Rules

Our pools are a great way to make the best of the warm, sunny California days. With that in mind, it's a good idea to remind yourself of the pool rules both for your safety and the safety of others.

Pool Rules Reminder

Gates must remain locked and shut at all times. Never give your key to anyone, and never let anyone in the gate.

There are no lifeguards on duty. The buddy system is to be used at all times. All children under 14 must be accompanied by a household member 18 years of age or older. This is STATE LAW.

Infants and Toddlers must wear a plastic swim diaper that has an elastic waist with elastic around both legs.

Discarded Items in Alleys

Discarded items such as mattresses, washers, dryers, etc are not to be left in the alleys. Please call Consolidated Disposal at 1 800 299-4898 for pickup. They will pickup one time per year. Notate on item who will pickup i.e., Disabled Vets, Salvation Army, Consolidated Disposal etc. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
